Fremont Community Theatre will be hosting a COVID spotlight show featuring Post-its® (notes on a marriage) and a Virtual Whodunnit on May 21, 22, and 23, 2021. Tim Bolton will be directing. Current restrictions for COVID allow us 47 seats in theatre, but Virtual Whodunnit will also be streamed on Saturday evening's performance. There will be a total of 4 performances, with a Saturday matinee also being offered. Graphics for the spotlight show were also shown during the meeting.

Auditions will be held on Sunday, March 28 for Post-its® and Monday, March 29 for a Virtual Whodunnit at Fremont Community Theatre. Virtual auditions will be available for those unable to meet in person and in-person auditions will be limited to 10 people. Masks must be worn and social distancing guidelines will be followed. The Fremont Community Teen Theatre and director Kyleigh Lash will be performing the Brothers Grimm Spectaculathon on July 9, 10, and 11, 2021. This show is a straight play one-act that is approximately 60 minutes long and will be limited to 20 teens. Auditions will be held May 30 and 31, 2021. Graphics for the teen show were also shown during the meeting.

The Fremont Community Youth Theatre and director Floyd Collins will be featuring the BBB press show, the Grunch, for camp this year. The show is 60 minutes, would be limited to just 20 campers, and would have one weekend of performances. Production dates are July 13 through July 28 (9:30am-12:00pm) with dress rehearsal on the 29th. Performance dates will be held on July 30, 31, and August 1, 2021 and the Saturday performance would also be livestreamed. Camper cost would be \$50, nonrefundable and would need to commit by May 23, 2021. Camp applications will go live on April 26, 2021 and will be posted as a link on our website, Facebook page, and Facebook groups at 9:00am. Graphics for the youth show were also shown during the meeting.
