Meeting called to order: Daleen Askins called the meeting to order at 6:00pm

Business

With Governor DeWine lifting all Covid restrictions and mandates on June 2, 2021, Fremont Community Theatre is able to resume business as usual, with no limits to seating or social distancing in place.

Randy Brown let us know that MTI (Music Theatre International) will be offering royalty free songs (15) for fundraisers on November 12-15, 2021.

Randy Brown motions that “the tickets for the regular season shows should remain at the same prices of \$15 for adults, \$12 for seniors and veterans, and \$5 for students (12th grade and under).” Floyd Collins accepted the motion and Cyrus Foos seconded. All approved, motion carried.

Randy Brown motions that “the teen ticket prices will remain at the same prices of \$12 for adults, \$10 for seniors and veterans, and \$5 for students (12th grade and under).” Floyd Collins accepted the motion and Cyrus Foos seconded. All approved, motion carried.

Daleen Askins motions that “the youth ticket prices will remain the same at \$8 for adults, \$6 for seniors and veterans, and \$5 for students (12th grade and under).” Randy Brown accepted the motion, and Cyrus Foos seconded. All approved, motion carried.

Mary Jo Foos proposes, “that Fremont Community Theatre sell season tickets again now that FCT will be at full capacity for the entire season, with each outstanding ticket stub from our previous season (Bench in the Sun, Mamma Mia) worth \$5 off a season ticket price.” Cyrus Foos made a motion to accept the proposal as stated and Daleen Askins accepted the motion. **Cyrus Foos amended the motion to add a disclaimer with the verbiage, “tickets are non-refundable due to circumstances beyond Fremont Community Theatre’s control.”** Daleen Askins accepted the amended motion. Floyd Collins seconded. All approved, motion carried.

Cyrus Foos made a motion, “for Fremont Community Theatre to sell 50/50 tickets with the method being coordinated at the director’s discretion.” Floyd Collins accepted and Randy Brown seconded. All approved, motion carried.

Floyd Collins made a motion, “for Fremont Community Theatre to resume serving refreshments during intermission provided the guidelines set by the FCT house manager are being followed.” Cyrus Foos accepted and Randy Brown seconded. All approved, motion carried.

Randy Brown made a motion to “have Sound Solutions quote and purchase dual projectors to install at Fremont Community Theatre, not to exceed \$12,000. Any higher amount will require further board consideration.” Floyd Collins accepted and Cyrus Foos seconded. All approved, motion carried.
